Oliver Richmond is well known for his work on peace in international relations. He is a Research Professor in IR, Peace and Conflict Studies in the Humanitarian and Conflict Response Institute at the University of Manchester. He is also International Professor, College of International Studies, Kyung Hee University, Korea, as well as a Visiting Professor at the Centre for Peace Studies, University of Tromsø. He is a fellow of the British Academy and is on numerous editorial and other boards, including that of the Review of International Studies. His recent publications include *Peace Formation and Post-Conflict Political Order*, (Oxford University Press, Forthcoming 2015), *Failed Statebuilding and Peace Formation* (Yale University Press, forthcoming September 2014), *A Very Short Introduction to Peace* (Oxford University Press, forthcoming October 2014), *A Post Liberal Peace* (Routledge, 2011), *Liberal Peace Transitions*, (with Jason Franks, Edinburgh University Press, 2009), *Peace in IR* (Routledge, 2008), and *The Transformation of Peace* (Palgrave, 2005/7). His work has been funded by grants from the Carnegie Trust, the British Academy, Leverhulme, and the EU Framework Programme. He is editor of the Palgrave book series, *Rethinking Peace and Conflict Studies* (with some 25 volumes published since 2005, and now one of Palgrave's flagship series), and co-editor of the Journal, *Peacebuilding*.
