- University as an apparatus of placement or displacement
- Conflict and displacement
- Displacement in peace (time)
- Development/modernization and displacement
- Economy and displacement
- Displacement by "national unity"
- Differences that do not add-up to a unified whole
- Borders that include are the borders that exclude
- Cultural diversity and exclusion within borders
- Expulsion and excommunication of Others inside
- Colonizing appropriations of the Other, epistemic violence, reductionism
- Inter- and cross-cultural communication

The language of our conference will be both English and Turkish.
